NOTICE TO MARINERS NO. 6 OF 2016

BLYTH HARBOUR – PUBLIC FIREWORKS EVENT

Sunday 30th October 1400hrs – 2000hrs.

All Mariners and Port users are advised that on Sunday the 30th October 2016 a public fireworks event will be staged at Blyth Harbour.

The fireworks shall be launched on the water from two temporary pontoons moored within the main channel for this purpose.

The location of the pontoons will be slightly up river adjacent to the old Pilot jetty anchored to the Eastern side of the main channel.

The pontoons will be positioned from approximately 1400hrs on the Sunday and then removed post display at approximately 1930hrs. **The fireworks shall be launched at 1900hrs.**

All vessel movements will be controlled and monitored by the Port Control with no movement authorised without prior approval from the Harbour Master, larger vessel movements maybe suspended for the duration of the event at the Harbour Masters discretion.

The Port Tug 'Blyth Endeavour' will be acting as the Guard / safety vessel throughout the event.

Normal procedures will resume immediately after the temporary pontoons have been removed from the main channel.

All of the above events shall be co-ordinated between the event organisers and the Harbour Masters office, regular broadcasts and updates regarding river activity and commercial vessel movements will be provided by Blyth Port Control on VHF Ch12.
