## NOTICE TO MARINERS NO 07 OF 2016

### Maintenance Dredging Operations.

Commencing date expected 8<sup>th</sup> December 2016 and continuing for a period of approximately 24hrs a very short programme of maintenance dredging will commence at the 37 Jetty & Ash barge dock area North Blyth.

This will include frequent trips to and from the spoil deposit ground approximately 3 miles ENE of the harbour East Pier.

The works will be undertaken over a 24 hour period by the vessel 'UKD Marlin' with latest information regarding the areas being dredged available on VHF Channel 12 (Blyth Harbour Radio).

All vessels are required to monitor VHF Channel 12 and avoid impeding vessels engaged in dredging operations; commercial vessel arrivals and departures will be directed by Blyth Port control as required.

During the works the following craft will be engaged in operations:

UKD MARLIN  
BLYTH ENDEAVOUR

SUCTION DREDGER  
TUG/BED LEVELLER

All craft will display the lights and shapes as prescribed in the International Regulations for Preventing Collisions at Sea and when working will keep a listening watch on VHF Channel 12.
