NOTICE TO MARINERS NO 01 OF 2017

IHC Complex Load out & Lifting Operations – South Harbour.

All mariners and South Harbour users are to be advised that complex project operations will be conducted over the South Harbour operational quays for a period of approximately 10 days as from Sunday 7th May 2017.

A 124m LOA barge shall be placed stern on to the North quay on Sunday PM 7th May 2017 prior to the heavy project load out expected Monday 8th May at 1100hrs, weather permitting.

The Tugs MTS Taktow, MTS Indus & Blyth Endeavour will be in attendance throughout the operating period.

There will be periods when leaving or entering the south harbour may be prohibited due to critical operations taking place and extreme caution must be observed whilst giving the barge and associated vessels a wide berth at all times. Vessel speeds and wash must be kept to a minimum.

All vessels shall observe the Harbour Masters directions at all times and exercise patience as required when operating in and around the south Harbour during the above periods – all operations are subject to safe weather conditions and timings and operations will be subject to change.
