The Port of Blyth is able to offer a comprehensive range of services, labour and equipment to visitors.

The Port of Blyth operates over 4 main ISPS secure terminals on the River Blyth with approximately 55 hectares of operational land feeding to 9 deep water berths.

Excellent access from sea is guaranteed by a tidal deep water port accessible in virtually all weather conditions. Vessels of up to 200m LOA and 35,000 DWT have direct access to open sea with no locks and no air draft restrictions. Port disbursements are competitive with berths suitable for jack up operations.

The Port also provides a wide range of additional, value adding services to support all our customers and their partners. A comprehensive in-house lift planning service can assist handling operations provided by fully qualified Port management who work closely with the client from early planning, to project completion.

The Port owns and manages over 3000 pieces of lifting equipment and operates a 24/7 stores facility, with flexible warehousing and external storage options available.
