Port of Blyth, the operating division of the Blyth Harbour Commission, is a modern statutory Trust Port handling 1 million tonnes of cargo each year with a group turnover in excess of £20 million. The Port handles a wide variety of trades, including from the offshore energy sector and has ambitious plans for future expansion.

The Role

The Blyth Harbour Commission oversees the strategy and management of the Port and is seeking to appoint a non-executive board member (Commissioner) to play an active role in delivering future growth and prosperity for the benefit of stakeholders which include employees, commercial and leisure port users, the local community and wider regional economy.

Applications are invited from candidates who can demonstrate proven extensive expertise and experience in the following areas:

- **A broad senior level of business management**
- **Knowledge of and active involvement in the offshore energy sector**

The successful candidate will also be able to demonstrate an interest in and knowledge of the region and Port of Blyth, while previous experience of a Non Exec Board position would be desirable not but essential.
