NOTICE TO MARINERS NO. 01 OF 2022 GENERAL NOTICE TO VISITING VESSELS

Port of Blyth – Unexploded Ordnance Survey – Battleship Wharf 4

Commencing date expected Saturday 18th March 2022 and continuing for a period of approximately 5 days a UXO survey will be carried out on Battleship Wharf 4 and running into the first 80m of Battleship Wharf 3.

The survey will comprise of multiple runs lines along the length of the berth and dredge box with the vessel towing survey equipment up to a 40m length astern of them, meaning that they will be restricted on their ability to manoeuvre.

A map of the intended survey area is attached. All vessels are requested to avoid this area while the survey is being carried out.

The works will be undertaken over a 12-hour period working between the hours of 0600–1800 by the vessel 'Humber Guardian'. The latest information regarding survey operations available on VHF Channel 12 (Blyth Harbour Radio).

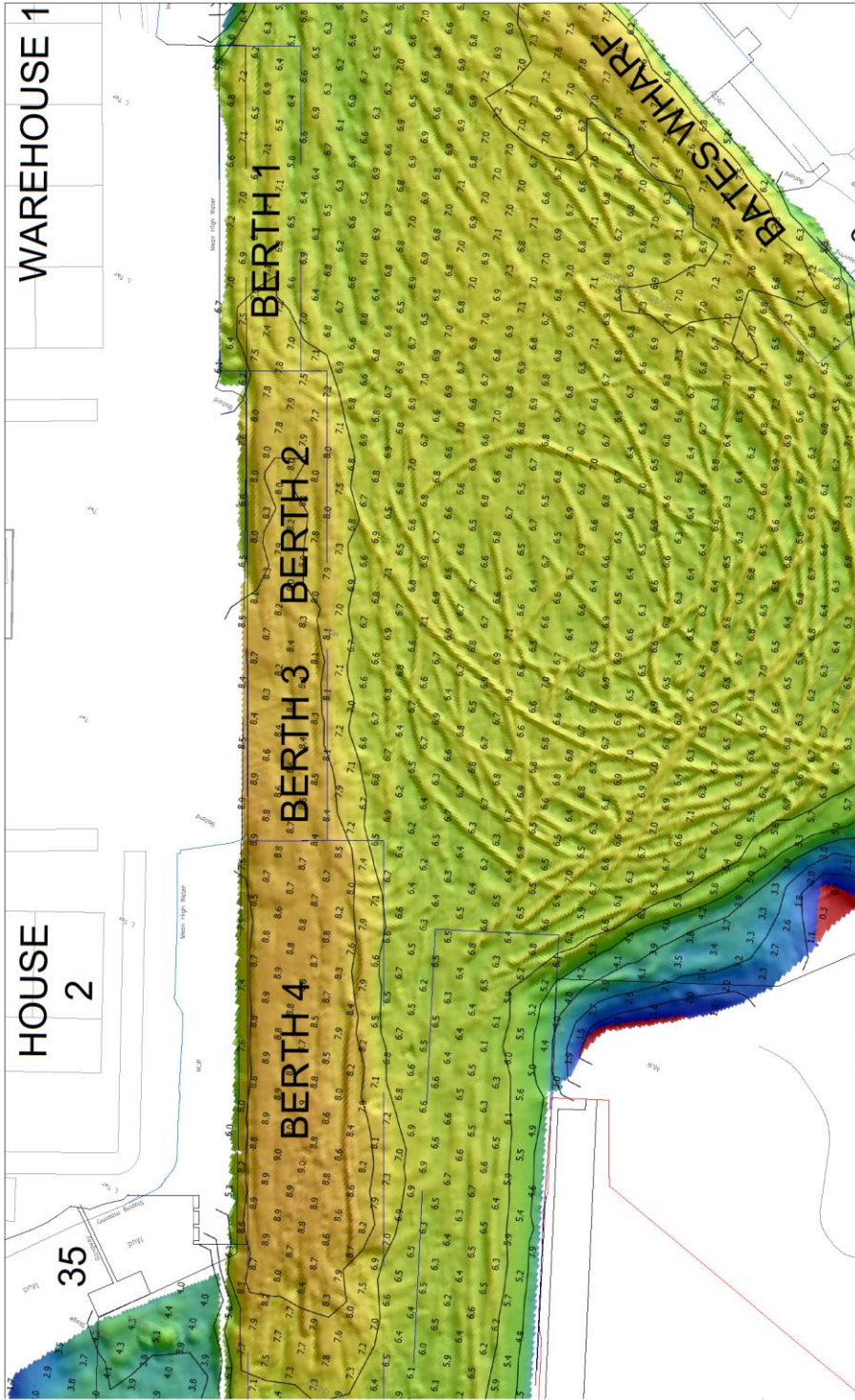
All vessels are required to monitor VHF Channel 12 and avoid impeding the survey vessel 'Humber Guardian' during survey operations; All vessel arrivals and departures and movements will be directed by Blyth Port control as required.

All survey craft will display the lights and shapes as prescribed in the International Regulations for Preventing Collisions at Sea and when working will keep a listening watch on VHF Channel 12.
