Energy Central Campus is a unique partnership between the Port of Blyth, Northumberland County Council and the Offshore Renewable Energy Catapult, with a mission to create the pipeline of talent required for the expanding clean energy sector, at the same time, inspiring, training and delivering pathways to employment for the local community.



PHASE 1

The Energy Central Learning Hub is a new STEM education and vocational training facility, developing energy sector skills and aspirations among young people at school and college, and adults re-training for new roles.



PHASE 2

The Energy Central Institute is a new higher-levels skills and innovation facility, developing energy sector expertise at degree and PhD levels.

The Energy Central Learning Hub is home to specialist STEM education and training facilities, equipping more people with the skills the renewables sector needs.

The Energy Central Learning Hub provides:

- Specialist facilities for vocational training, including modular skills courses.
- Inspires young people to consider a career in the clean energy sector through major regional STEM hub (Energy Central STEM)
- Encourages collaboration between employers, educators and researchers through unique employer membership opportunities and dedicated conferencing spaces.
- A unique visitor attraction showcasing the diverse roles available in the regions clean energy sector.



Overview of the Energy Central Learning Hub Facilities

Based at the Port of Blyth, facilities include:

- Specialist electrical and mechanical workshops
- Classrooms
- Major regional STEM hub
- Digital skills training facilities
- Clean Energy focused Visitor Centre
- Conferencing and events space for up to 250 people

Located in the heart of one of the UK's largest clean energy clusters, the facility is developing the next generation of skilled clean energy sector workers.
