## NOTICE TO MARINERS NO. 11-2026 GENERAL NOTICE TO PORT USERS

### **Correct PPE in Operational Areas**

#### **F.A.O Vessel Agents & Vessel Masters**

It is a requirement that Hi-Visibility garments are worn by all persons within the Port operational areas at all times, and hard hats during vessel cargo operations. This includes vessel crews proceeding ashore.

It is the vessel Masters duty to inform crew members of this essential safety requirement and the individual crew member's responsibility to comply with port safety instructions.

If crew members are observed leaving the vessel without the required PPE they will be escorted back to the vessel until properly attired.

A dedicated painted pedestrian walkway away from the working quays is available and should be always used when proceeding ashore. Hi-Visibility garments can be left and recovered at the main port building when leaving the port operational area.

The port of Blyth cannot accept responsibility or liability for any incident / injury to persons not complying with port safety guidance.

Please bring this notice to all vessels and crews expected to operate within the Port of Blyth restricted operational areas.
