Public Safety Notice to Harbour Users

Blyth Harbour West Pier – Restricted Access Notice

Due to storm damage at the seaward end of the West Pier at South Harbour, members of the general public and other visitors are advised that access to the end of the West Pier is **restricted until essential repairs have been completed and the area is made safe**.

Access prevention measures and appropriate warning signage are in place to protect the public. All safety instructions must be followed to avoid personal risk. CCTV surveillance will also be in operation to help enhance public safety.

Blyth Harbour Commissioners will take all necessary steps to secure and repair the pier; however, these works may take a considerable period of time before full access can be restored.

To allow **limited safe public access** during this period, the pier has been closed approximately **90 metres from the seaward end**. Members of the public are asked to respect this closure for their own safety.

The public may continue to use the **permitted, open, and safe sections** of Blyth Harbour West Pier for angling, walking, and sightseeing. Visitors are reminded to remain mindful of their own safety and that of others while at Blyth Harbour and within the surrounding environment.
